The first vines for Wairau River were planted in 1978 around the home of Phil and Chris Rose, and we are honouring that foresight by releasing this range of wines expressing the unique terrior of this home block on the banks of the Wairau River.

Initial vibrant gooseberry fruit aromas are complemented by subtle oak and mineral nuances. The palate is luscious and seamless from extended lees contact with the added dimension of gunflint aroma and creamy texture.
