



## WAIRAU RIVER CHARDONNAY 2006

*Marlborough's Wairau River (pronounced why-raow) has carved an intricate braided pattern of channels on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978. Meticulous management of the family estates ensures only exceptional parcels of fruit are destined for the flagship Wairau River label.*

*This wine has lifted aromas of tropical fruit, white peach and subtle toasty oak. Its palate has intense stone fruit flavours from ripe fruit and nutty flavours from French oak supported with a fine acid structure to give a seamless finish. Enjoy with mouth watering morsels and mirth.*
