GEWÜRZTRAMINER 2005

Marlborough's Wairau River is Maori for 'many waters', reflecting the intricate braided pattern the river has carved on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978, thus starting a tradition of crafting world class wines which continues today. The river pattern also symbolizes the family roots with its interwoven strands moving together in the same direction.

Classic rose petal and Turkish delight aromas lead to flavours of tropical lychee flavours which typify this variety. The clean acid and fine structure provide good palate weight with a warm finish. Enjoy this wine with joyfulness and delight.
