GEWÜRZTRAMINER 2006

Marlborough's Wairau River is Maori for 'many waters', reflecting the intricate braided pattern the river has carved on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978, thus starting a tradition of crafting world class wines which continues today. The river pattern also symbolizes the family roots with its interwoven strands moving together in the same direction.

Intense Turkish delight and spice aromas lift off the nose. The palate expresses concentrated flavours of musk and ginger which typify this variety. The wine is rich with a viscous texture and finishes with considerable length. Enjoy with mischief and spice.
