PINOT GRIS 2005

Marlborough's Wairau River is Maori for 'many waters', reflecting the intricate braided pattern the river has carved on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978, thus starting a tradition of crafting world class wines which continues today. The river pattern also symbolizes the family roots with its interwoven strands moving together in the same direction.

Displaying succulent ripe pear on the nose typical of Pinot Gris, this medium dry style has mouth filling flavours of aromatic spices and quince and has a rounded satisfying finish. Enjoy this wine with good times and good people.
