## PINOT GRIS 2007

*Marlborough's Wairau River is Maori for 'many waters', reflecting the intricate braided pattern the river has carved on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978, thus starting a tradition of crafting world class wines which continues today. The river pattern also symbolizes the family roots with its interwoven strands moving together in the same direction.*

*Displaying succulent ripe pear aromas this dry style wine has mouth filling aromatic flavours of spice and quince with a truly satisfying rounded finish. The richly textured wine has a weighty lushness displaying great weight and length. Savour with spontaneity and deep belly laughs.*
