PINOT NOIR 2006

Marlborough's Wairau River (pronounced why-raow) has carved an intricate braided pattern of channels on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978. Meticulous management of the family estates ensures only exceptional parcels of fruit are destined for the flagship Wairau River label.

The nose opens up with bright red berry fruit aromas framed with toasty oak. The palate has a rich velvety texture obtained from low cropped vines, complemented by soft ripe tannins. Enjoy with soul food & good times.
