RIESLING 2006

Marlborough's Wairau River is Maori for 'many waters', reflecting the intricate braided pattern the river has carved on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978, thus starting a tradition of crafting world class wines which continues today. The river pattern also symbolizes the family roots with its interwoven strands moving together in the same direction.

Concentrated aromas of ripe stone fruit and citrus blossom are supported with floral notes. The palate has intense citrus fruit flavours balanced by cleansing mineral acidity. This dry wine expresses fruit sweetness and fine acid balance to give richness and tension. Savour with fine company and spectacular conversation.
