RIESLING 2007

Marlborough's Wairau River is Maori for 'many waters', reflecting the intricate braided pattern the river has carved on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978, thus starting a tradition of crafting world class wines which continues today. The river pattern also symbolizes the family roots with its interwoven strands moving together in the same direction.

Incredibly intense aromas of dried apricot, lemon and talc reflect the concentration obtained from low yielding vines. The palate has an initial explosion of stone-fruit and citrus flavours followed by a taught structure and balanced by the flinty acidity. Enjoy with fine company and spectacular conversation.
